






Thank You HRC Judges

During the 2008 Annual Meeting, the Board of Directors approved a motion to give HRC Judges a jacket as a thank you for their service to the organization. A similar jacket is given to Handlers who have earned 500 points.

The HRC Judge gives up many weekends of his/her time in order for members to enter their dogs in a UKC sanctioned hunt test and earn points. There are over 200 active judges in HRC and the demand for more judges is on the increase. HRC conducts over 300 hunt tests per year which the judges preside over.

There are 5 levels of achievement that will be recognized for an HRC Judge.

	100 HRC Hunt Test Judging Assignments.
	200 HRC Hunt Test Judging Assignments.

Upon the completion of 33 judging assignments, a judge will receive a jacket and 1 gold star to pin above the HRC lettering. When 50 hunt tests are accomplished, the judge will receive an additional star up to the limit of 5 for having judged 200 hunt tests. HRC will keep track of the number of events judged. HRC provides one jacket per judge.

Initial distribution of the Judges Jackets began during the 2009 Annual Meeting.
