Directions to Headquarters:

Swallowfield Road is North of Duncan and South of Chemainus. Turn East off of the #1 Trans-Canada Highway onto Mt. Sicker Rd. Follow Mt. Sicker Rd. to the T junction, and then turn Left onto Chemainus Rd. When you reach Crofton Rd stay left, and after about 100m turn Right onto Swallowfield Road (look for the HRC sign). Drive through the gate, proceed until you reach the T junction, and then turn Right. Headquarters is located at the Hydroxyl field area.

HRC signs will help guide the way.
