Take US 72 East towards Scottsboro, take the AL 35 exit. Go approx. 13 miles on AL 35 and turn right onto Co Rd 100. Travel approx. 2 miles, Northeast Alabama Hunting Preserve will be on your right.

From Chattanooga

Take 159 South to Ft. Payne. Take exit 218 and turn right onto AL 35. Go 13 miles and turn left onto Co Rd 100. Travel approx. 2 miles, Northeast Alabama Hunting Preserve will be on your right.

From Birmingham

Take I-59 North to Ft Payne. Take exit 218 and turn left onto AL 35. Go 13 miles and turn left onto Co Rd 100. Travel approx. 2 miles, Northeast Alabama Hunting Preserve will be on your right.
