Continue south about two miles – look for the Lilly Sand & Gravel Sign on the right. Turn north (right) into the Parking Area. GPS Coordinates (Latitude, Longitude 40.739107600, -98.568040900). **Check-in:** Check will begin at 7:00 AM. Handlers meeting will be at 7:30 AM. Test will begin at 8:00 AM.
