A WALKUP FEE of \$10 per test will apply after the online closing occurs. No exceptions!

A special **Youth Hunt** will be held, with registration taking place at Headquarters until 2:00pm Saturday. The hunt will be for handlers age 14 and under, and the cost is **\$10.00**. The Youth Hunt will take place at the conclusion of the Started Test. Participants may use any dog trained to any level. They may have help from a parent or mentor if needed. Poppers will be fired by a Bubba Gunner. The test can be run as a double or singles, at the discretion of the handler. The test will be two simple marks, no more than 60-70 yards, with an (optional) simple blind. Awards will be given at the banquet.

Test Headquarters is located at the Trimble Community Building.

- From downtown Smithville, go approximately 5 miles north on Highway 169 to Trimble.
- Turn right (east) on County Road 308 / 208th Street.
- Almost immediately, the road turns left (north) onto 1st Street.
- Take the first right onto Oak to a stop sign two blocks ahead. Continue straight ahead on Oak to the Community Building.
- Limited Parking is available. Parking along the street is allowed.
- Signs will be posted to assist in finding locations.
- No open bottle alcohol, or firearms will be allowed on the premises.**
- Please pick up after your dog when at Headquarters!

Check In: Check-in will begin at 7:00am both Saturday and Sunday at the Test Headquarters. All tests will begin promptly at 8:00am. **A bitch-check will be held outside of headquarters each morning. It is the responsibility of the handlers to get every female checked both days prior to leaving for the test sites. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Clothing and Gear: All participants must wear camo hunting attire appropriate for a Kansas/Missouri duck, or dark goose hunt. Waterproof boots may be required for Seasoned & Finished tests. Rain gear, sun-screen, and bug repellent are suggested. Bring plenty of water for yourself and your dog. Shade will be limited at some test sites.

Saturday Banquet & Raffle: Following Saturdays tests, please join us at Test Headquarters for a fried/baked chicken dinner, ribbon ceremony, and raffle event. Dinner may be purchased for \$10.00. Children 10 and under eat free. Thank you for supporting our club!

- **Lunch is NOT provided. Subway is located in Smithville.**
