A special **Youth Hunt** will be held, with registration taking place at Headquarters until 2:00pm Saturday. The hunt will be for handlers age 14 and under, and the cost is **\$10.00**. The Youth Hunt will take place at the conclusion of the Started Test. Participants may use any dog trained to any level. They may have help from a parent or mentor if needed.

Poppers will be fired by a Bubba Gunner. The test can be run as a double or singles, at the discretion of the handler. The test will be two simple marks, no more than 60-70 yards, with an (optional) simple blind. Awards will be given at the banquet.

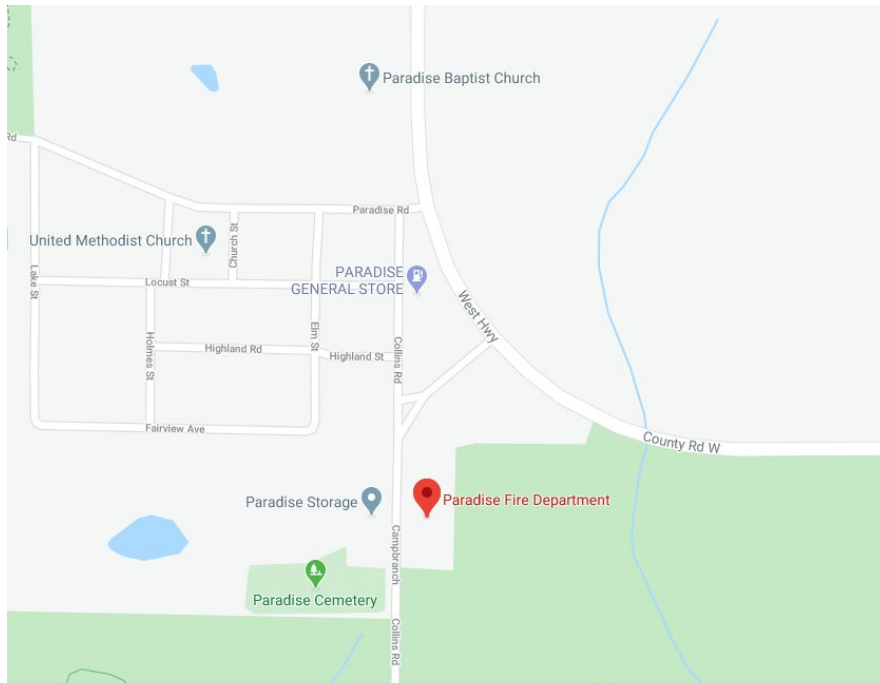

Test Headquarters is located at the Paradise Fire Dept

- From downtown Smithville, go approximately 4 miles north on Hwy 169 to county road W.
- Turn right (East) on W.
- Follow W until you reach the Paradise General Store in Paradise.
- The Fire Dept is visible from the gas station.
- Limited Parking is available. Parking along the street is allowed.
- Signs will be posted to assist in finding locations.
- No open bottle alcohol, or firearms will be allowed on the premises.**
- Please pick up after your dog when at Headquarters!

Check In: Check-in will begin at 7:00am both Saturday and Sunday at the Test Headquarters. All tests will begin promptly at 8:00am.

A bitch-check will be held outside of headquarters each morning. It is the responsibility of the handler to get every female checked both days prior to leaving for the test sites. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Clothing and Gear: All participants must wear camo hunting attire appropriate for a Kansas/Missouri duck, or dark goose hunt. Waterproof boots may be required for Seasoned & Finished tests. Rain gear, sunscreen, and bug repellent are suggested. Bring plenty of water for yourself and your dog. Shade will be limited at most test sites.

Saturday Banquet & Raffle: Following Saturdays tests, please join us at Test Headquarters for a dinner, ribbon ceremony, and raffle event. Dinner is complimentary for test participants. Thank you for your support!
