The members of Felsenthal HRC would like to invite you and your family to join us Saturday and Sunday, September 26 & 27, 2020, for our hunt test weekend. While we all enjoy the social aspects of our organization, the following changes have been implemented for everyone's safety and well-being:

1. By entering this hunt test, you are agreeing to and will be required to assist with bird tech duties. Marshals will work with handlers to rotate bird tech duties while providing everyone time to run their dogs.
2. A drive-up check-in will be put in place. At this point, you will be given your booklet and a map.
3. If you enter 6 dogs, you must bring someone to load wingers or plant blinds. For those running 10 or more dogs, we are asking that you bring 2 bird techs.
5. There will be no walk-up entries for any category.
4. Lunches will not be sold on site, but meals will be delivered to each test site for workers.
5. Point receipts and ribbons will be passed out as a flight finishes.
6. Each person attending this event is responsible for their own personal protection equipment.

Felsenthal HRC will follow regulations and guidelines put in place by the state at the time of the event.
