With Bird Tech availability up in the air, handlers need to be prepared to throw birds.

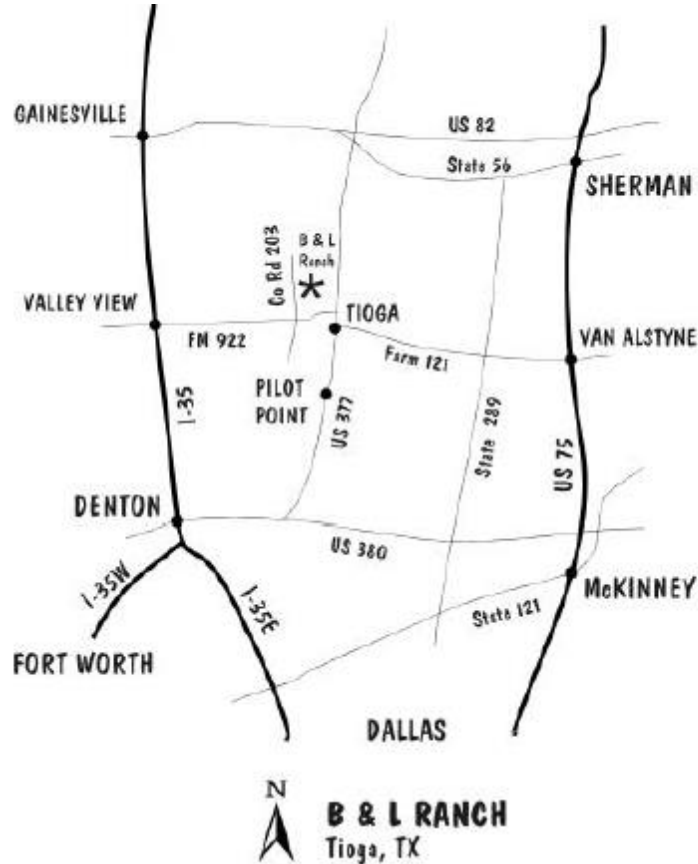
