Page 33- Manners and Obedience

CURRENT RULE WORDING: Seasoned, Finished, Grand and Upland hunting retrievers should walk quietly at heel off lead, sit quietly in any position designated by the handler, and honor (when required) in a quiet manner.

PROPOSED CHANGE: Seasoned, Finished, Grand and Upland hunting retrievers should walk quietly at heel off lead, sit quietly in any location designated by the handler, and honor (when required) in a quiet manner in either a sitting or standing position.

JUSTIFICATION: This rule change will allow both the honor dog and working dog the same ability to see all of the marks and ensure they both will have the same views during the entire marking scenario.
