REMEMBER GUN SAFETY & SPORTSMANSHIP

PLEASE READ REGARDING COVID-19:

*COVID-19 restrictions in the state of Pennsylvania are currently easing, however previous restrictions may return which could result in the cancellation of the event. Should the event be cancelled, entry fees will be refunded minus fees charged by HuntSecretary.com.

*All in attendance at the hunt test are attending at their own risk and are asked NOT to attend if they have symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

*High Flyers Hunting Retriever Club requests that all persons present at the test be respectful of others' concerns.

*All handlers will be responsible for following current CDC guidelines in the state of Pennsylvania for the use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE's) and for maintaining required social distances. Vehicles should be parked with sufficient distance between them to ensure social distancing. Please avoid congregating and refrain from touching dogs that are not under your supervision.

*Handlers who choose to wear gloves must have them pre-approved by the judges prior to the start of the test. ALL ATTIRE must be hunting appropriate per the guidelines stated in the 2021 HRC Rulebook.

*ALL ATTENDEES, HANDLERS, AND JUDGES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING THEIR OWN PPE's, including masks, gloves, and sanitizing products. Judges, Program Directors, and Marshals should bring their own pens and pencils if they do not wish to use the ones supplied by the club.
