ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

CHECK-IN STARTS AT 6:30 AM EACH DAY. All handlers must check in with the Hunt Secretary by 7:30 AM. Handlers/owners not checking in by 7:30 AM are subject to removal and running entry given to dogs on wait list or walk-ups, if any.

Owner/handlers may NOT substitute dogs for any reason after the Close date (2/22/22) and prior to the test date without approval of the Hunt Secretary. If a handler removes a dog, for any reason, that running entry will be given to the next dog on the wait list or a walk-up, if any. A handler with multiple dogs who removes a dog may place another dog at the end of the wait list, if any.
