REMEMBER GUN SAFETY & SPORTSMANSHIP

DIRECTIONS TO HUNT TEST AREA AND HEADQUARTERS / STABLES:

DIRECTIONS: From the intersection of Interstate Highway 64 (Missouri Highway 40/61) and Missouri Route 94 proceed West on Route 94. When you get to Highway D turn right, and then proceed to the entrance of the conservation area on the right. Signs for each stake will be clearly posted once you enter the property.

HEADQUARTERS/STABLES: The hunt test headquarters will be at the stables. Upon turning into Busch turn right at the first stop sign, and then take the next left. The stable is the brown building on the right. Please come to the stable/headquarters first thing each morning for check-in and bitch check (ALL females must be checked, even if they are spayed).
